

2010 Crumley Roberts Crib to College Next Step Scholarship Program Guidelines and Regulations

Crumley Roberts will award five (5) non-renewable \$1,000 scholarships and a laptop computer to Community College students, in select counties in the State of North Carolina based on the following: **(A list of all applicable counties are listed at the end of this document)**

1. Applicant must be a Community College Student who will be transferring to an accredited 4 year college or university in Fall 2010. Crumley Roberts employees and their family members are not eligible to enter.
2. Applicants will be judged on a written essay.
3. Applicants must have at least a 2.5 GPA or better to apply.
4. Applicants must also provide three letters of recommendation including one from a family member, one from an educator/ teacher and one from a friend or other community member.

Guidelines for submitting the application:

1. The application may be printed out by locating the Crib to College Next Step scholarship link on Crumley Roberts website. www.CrumleyRoberts.com
2. Please fill out all fields. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. The written essay must be 1000 words or less.

4. Applicants must have an official transcript from their Community College, letter of intent or acceptance from the College or University, letters of recommendation, application, and essay sent to the following address:
